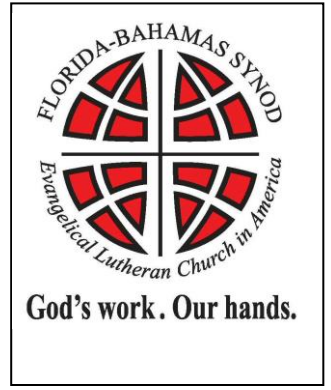

- fill in your name, email address, and select Daily Bible Reading, and YOU'RE DONE!
