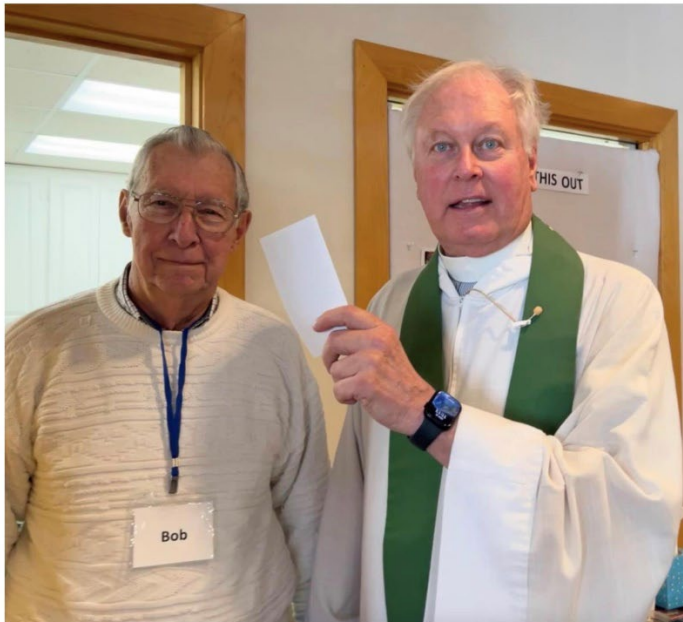

Photo of the Week: Living Lord Lutheran Church, Vero Beach



Living Lord Lutheran Church member and Fundraising Chair Bob Bender (left) and Pastor Greg Shreaves received the final donation in late January 2023 to pay off the church's mortgage at just under \$280,000. The church started this campaign in the late spring of 2022 with a goal of receiving enough donations to pay off the mortgage by late 2024. This check represents the final amount to completely pay off its mortgage. "We can now free up this monthly obligation on our building and grounds to do some really amazing work in our community and beyond," Pastor Greg Shreaves said. "Bob Bender took on this project and single-handedly completed this amazing work in under a year," he added. "We're grateful for the support and enthusiasm that our people have exhibited in this effort," Pastor Greg said.
